In accordance with our Constitution, nominations can be made in either of two ways:

- 1. Prospective candidates can file a nomination form with the Secretary by Friday, March 16, 2018, by 5:00 p.m. at the Union office or at the March membership meeting on Tuesday, March 20, 2018. The nomination form must be signed by five members in good standing, or
- 2. Nominations can be made from the floor at the Tuesday, March 20, 2018 membership meeting, Ocean Campus, MUB 140, 3:00 5:00pm. Nomination form should be mailed or delivered to: election officer AFT 2121, 311 Miramar Ave., San Francisco, CA 94112 to arrive in the office by 5:00pm on Friday, March 16, 2018.
