AFT 2121 Resolution on College Leadership

Whereas, AFT 2121 is a union local that is committed to quality public education; and

Whereas, the CCSF Board of Trustees just signed the agreement with AFT 2121 whereby faculty accepted individual sacrifice that included significant salary concessions in order to prioritize students and the college community; and

Whereas, CCSF finds itself in the midst of a fiscal crisis due to funding methodology which narrows the vision of a community college, and

Whereas, CCSF administration has contributed to the fiscal crisis by neglecting to aggressively increase our FTES, our main source of revenue, which has been funded at minimum at the 2017-18 apportionment rates; and

Whereas, since the state take-over of CCSF in 2012, the administration has systematically harmed enrollment by reducing course offerings, halting marketing and outreach, failing to implement a functional registration system, stopping the publication of a simple and comprehensive course schedule; therefore be it

Resolved, AFT 2121 demands that the Board of Trustees appoint an accountable and visionary acting chancellor that is committed to the broad mission of Community Colleges; and be it finally

Resolved, AFT 2121 recommends appointing Anita Martinez as acting chancellor, beginning July 1, 2021, until a permanent chancellor is found.
