Fair contract NOW

Our AFT 2121 Bargaining Team returned to the negotiating table with the District on August 12th, proposing an across-the-board raise, including a 3.7% restoration (to 2007 salary levels) and an additional 16% over three years to address losses to inflation and restore competitive salaries at City College. Despite repeatedly indicating they would bring a compensation proposal to the table, the District deferred. Instead they proposed changes in faculty evaluation procedures that would transfer more authority from faculty peers to administration. After hearing AFT objections to the District evaluation proposal at bargaining last week they backpedaled, stating that we were misreading their "intent."
