

Articles 18.D & 18.I – LOAD (TA 5.2.18)

- Change the name of “Credit Lecture Laboratory (Science-Related Disciplines Only)” to “Credit Lecture Laboratory - A”
- Change the name of “Credit Lecture Laboratory” to “Credit Lecture Laboratory - B”
- Move all Clinical Labs in Nursing and Allied Health into Credit Lecture Laboratory – A (Change from (75% to 85%)
- Move all Computer Science Labs into Credit Lecture Laboratory – A (Change from (75% to 85%)
- Pay all classes previously called “Conference” at the lecture rate of 100%, even if those classes are currently called ‘Lab’. (Change from (85% to 100%)
- Establish a new non-credit composition load factor at 75% (20 hours) to be applied to classes such as ESL 3180 (Change from 60% to 75%)

18.I Full-Time Equivalent Definition for the Purpose of Reporting Service Credit to STRS

4. For the purpose of crediting service under Education Code § 22138.5, the District is required to report a minimum standard of 525 instructional hours per school year. For purposes of compliance with Education Code § 22138.5 and reporting STRS service credit, the hours of creditable service the District reports for temporary, part-time faculty in a school year in order to earn the compensation earnable for creditable service performed on a full-time basis shall be as follows:
